

Ontario Goat Futurity Registration



Registration Eligibility and Information

ELIGIBILITY: The purpose of this class is to challenge, select and nominate Does that will develop into the best 2-year olds. All Does nominated must be eligible to compete as 2-year olds. Base date for Futurity class is November 1st. This show is open only to Does that are Canadian bred and owned. The three payment deadlines are as follows: First payment, October 1st, 2010;
Second payment, October 1st, 2011;
Third payment, October 1st, 2012.

FUTURITY LOCATION: This show will be held at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair in Toronto, Ontario.

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Anyone may enter a Doe by submitting a completed entry form (see following page) along with the specified entry fee. The following year, these people will receive a notice for a second entry payment. This procedure will continue for a third payment. The animals for which three Futurity payments have been made and which have been appropriately entered at the show where the Futurity will be held will be eligible to be shown in the Futurity. When a female entered in the Futurity is sold, it is the responsibility of the owner to notify the co-ordinator of the change in ownership and to inform the buyer that this animal has been entered in the Futurity. It is then the responsibility of the buyer to submit subsequent fees in accordance with the rules and closing dates. The postmark shall determine eligibility of meeting the closing date requirements.

ENTRY FEES: First payment \$5.00; second payment \$10.00; third payment \$15.00. When the nomination fees and subsequent payments in connection with the Futurity are received, they are committed to the purse of this event and no refunds will be made. The only exception is that, should any condition arise which prevents the showing in this Futurity, the right is reserved to cancel the event and pay to the persons owning the females eligible at the time of cancellation their prorata share of all monies accrued in the Futurity after deduction of the actual expenses incurred in the administration of it.

PURSE: The funds will be put towards prizes/prize monies for the show and the purse will be divided as follows: 1st - 30%, 2nd - 25%, 3rd - 20%, 4th - 15%, 5th - 10%.

JUDGE SELECTION: The official judge of the open show will also serve as the official for the futurity.

NOTE: This show is open to Alpine, La Mancha, Nubian, Saanen, Toggenburg and Recorded Grades. Each breed will show separately. The amount of prize money awarded will vary from each breed depending on the number of entries received.
